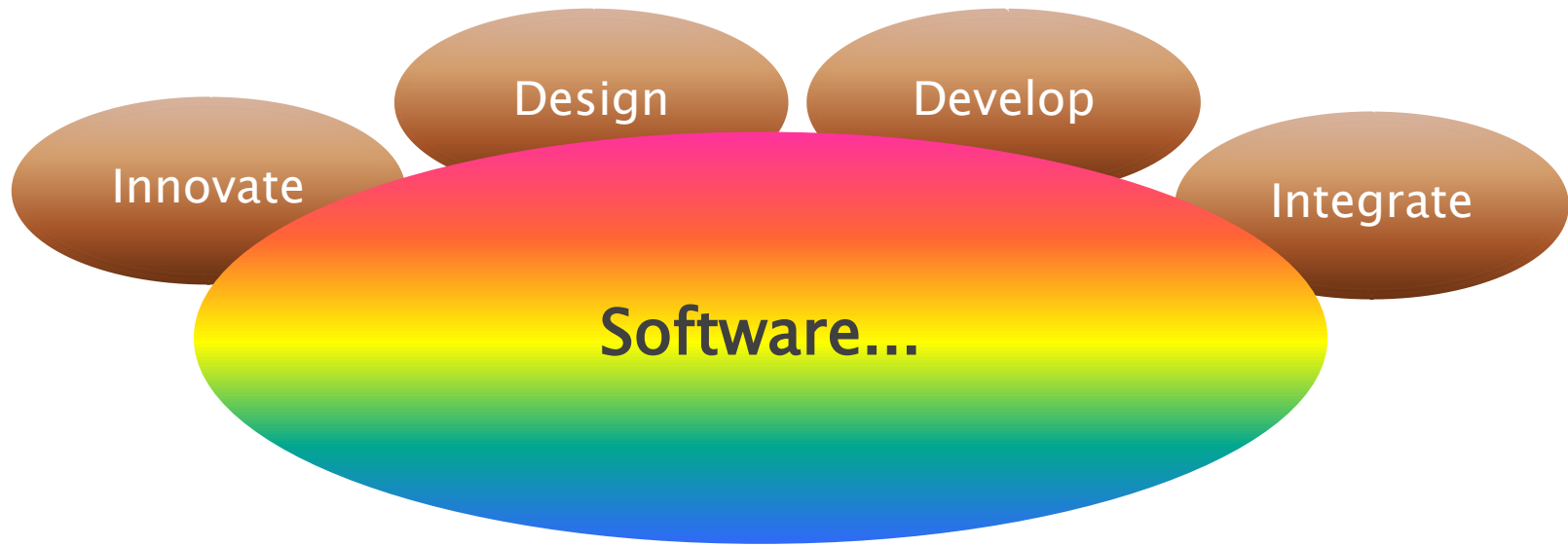

- ▶ Started as a personal project of Ali Özgür on 2007
- ▶ Published InfoSQL at 2008
- ▶ Became PragmaSQL on early days of 2009
- ▶ Evolved to PragmaTouch on February 2010 with additions to the team
- ▶ Published the first iOS app, JiraTouch, on February 2010
- ▶ Published mTouch for Moodle on April 2010
- ▶ Published mTouch+, iPad optimized mTouch, on September 2010
- ▶ Developed various iOS games and apps
